Over the counter drugs are safe and effective:

According to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), over-the-counter drugs are as safe and effective as prescription drugs. These medications can help improve common symptoms such as:

fever acne

 allergies, cough and cold athlete's foot

 stomach reflux pain

 constipation • any deficiency requiring the use of vitamins.

Benefits of using your over-the-counter drug coverage

- Get significant savings because they are less expensive than other prescription drugs.
- Having access to a variety of medicines to treat your health conditions.

How to use your over-the-counter drugs coverage?

- Although OTC drugs do not contain federal legend, it is necessary that the doctor provides a written prescription indicating OTC and that he or she includes the over-the-counter products that you need for your health care. The prescription must Indicate OTC so the pharmacist can process the supply of OTC products correctly, through the electronic payment system.
- The OTC drug must be under one of the categories covered by the plan, mentioned in the table of OTC drugs.
- When visiting any of our extensive pharmacy network, present your health plan card and the prescription for OTC drugs.
